No. 28.408. Thomas George R. C. Harkless of Shelby County,
Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of
the United States a Certificate of the Registry of the Land
Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full pay-
ment has been made by the said George R. C. Harkless
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the
24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An Act making further
provisions for the sale of the Public Lands," for the
first half of the North East Quarter of Section Twenty
five in Township Twenty One of Range three West, in

the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing eighty acres and twenty nine hundredths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said George R. C. Harless.

Now, know ye, that the said United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, warrant and granteth and by these presents do give and grant unto the said George R. C. Harless and to his heirs, the said Tract-a-bore described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said George R. C. Harless and to his heirs and assigns forever, on Testimony whereof I Franklin Pierce President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
