 of is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed
 and sold unto the said Jesse T. Bell the following de
 scribed tract, pieces or parcels of land, to-wit: The West
 half of the N.E. Quarter of section fourteen, except ten acres
 lying in the N.E. corner of said half Quarter, laid off
 by a square by line running parallel with the N.E.
 lines of said half Quarter in which M. M. Alexander
 now lies. Also ten acres lying on the West side of E.
 half of the Quarter section, bounded as follows, by
 Spring Creek on the North, the Church lot on the East

and the line dividing said description Quarter Section on the West, or which the same corner as the Harrell house now stands, said lands lying and being in Section fourteen, Township Twenty-Six, Range 3 West and in the above named County and State, said in the Tuscaloosa land district. To have and to hold the above described lands to the said Jesse T. Bell and his heirs in fee simple forever. And the said parties of the first part do warrant and will forever defend the same to the said Bell and his heirs against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
