Whereas, Joseph Hale of Shelby County, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, in Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Joseph Hale according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty-six, of Township Twenty-one, of Range Three West, in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing Seventy Nine acres and Ninety six hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, reproduced to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Joseph Hale.

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Joseph Hale, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Joseph Hale and to his heirs and assigns forever.
