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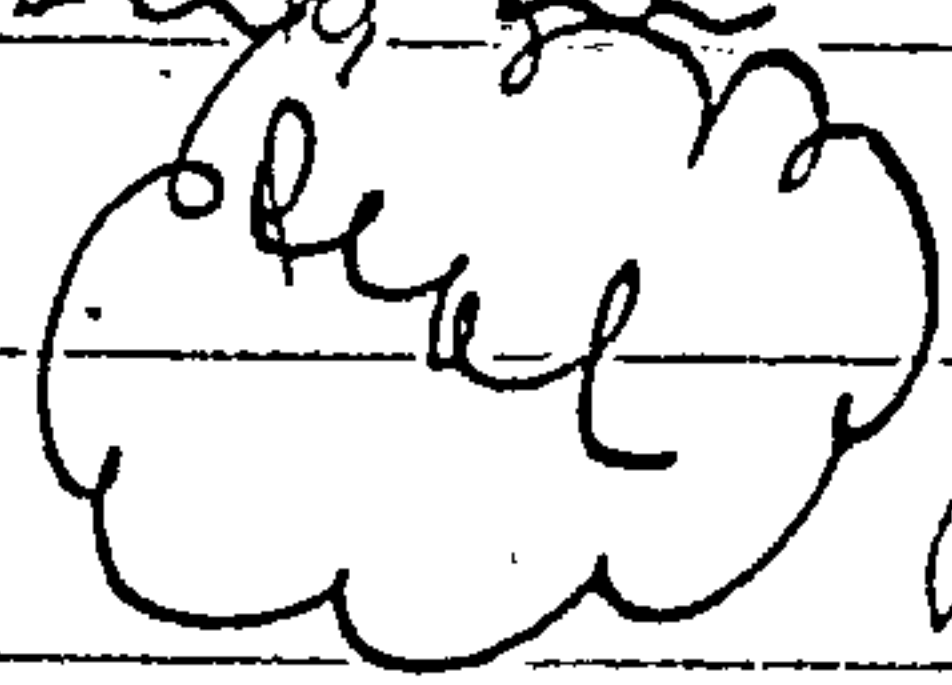

Whereas Rhoda Moroney, assignee of James M. Bartney, of Jackson County, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James M. Bartney, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South West Quarter of Section Fifteen of Township Twenty two of Range Three West in the district of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing eighty Acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James M. Bartney.

Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents do give and grant unto the said Rhoda Moroney the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Rhoda Moroney and to his heirs and assigns forever.
