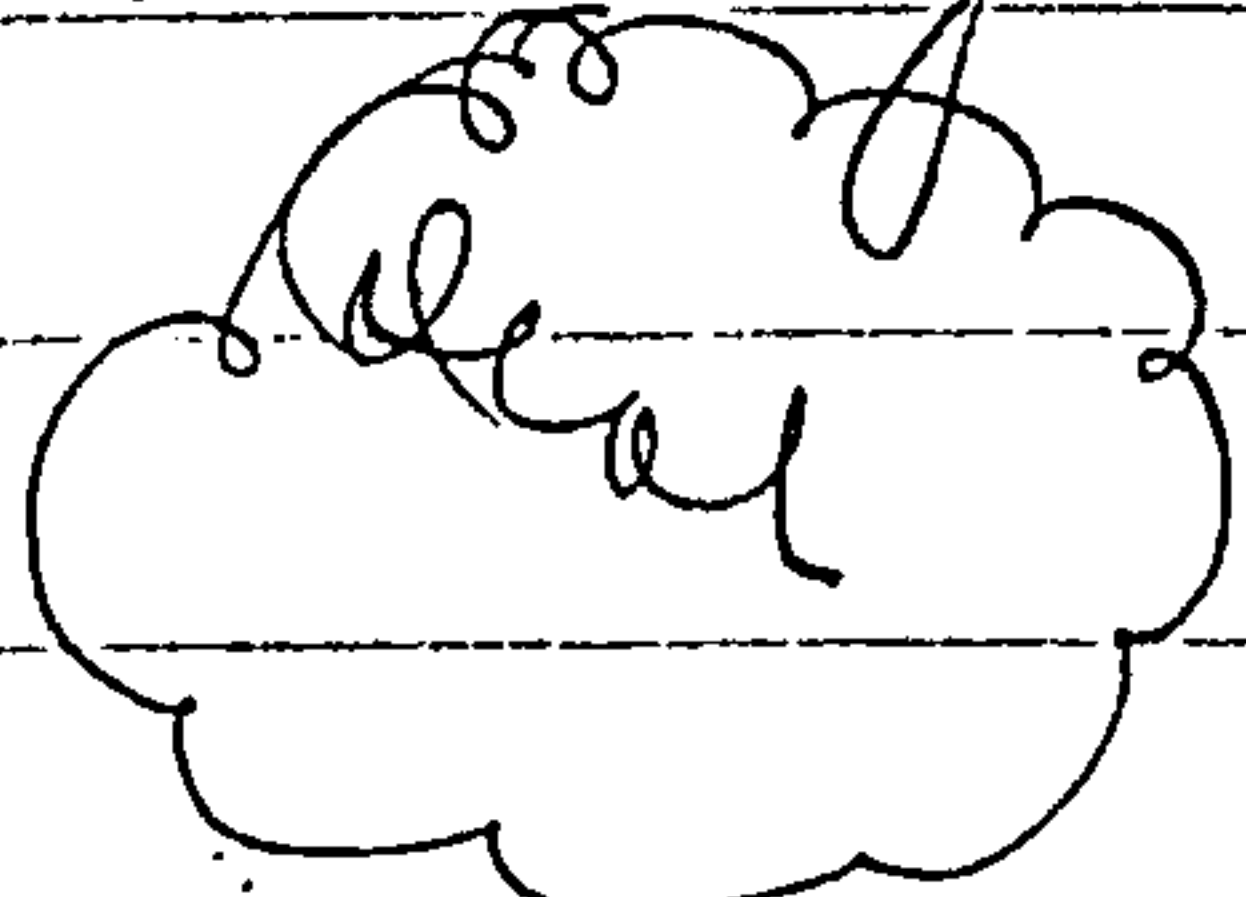

bama, containing Eighty acres and Twenty Nine hundredths of an acre,
according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands,
returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General,
which said tract has been purchased by the said William Wilson.
Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration
of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Con-
gress, in such case made and provided, have given and
