 Nash Branch of the second part, all of the County and State
 aforesaid, Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part hath
 this day bargained and sold and do by these presents grant,
 bargain sell and convey unto the party of the second part
 certain lots in the town of Helena to-wit: Lots No. 4 and 5 in
 Block 15 and in the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 15 Township
 Twenty Range Three East and located as follows, Commenc-
 ing at a certain point on the East side of Second street,
 thence running 463 $\frac{7}{10}$ feet in a Northerly direction from
 S.W. Corner of Block 15; thence Easterly 98 $\frac{3}{10}$ ft to Main street
