years, be, and she is hereby relieved of the Disabilities of
Non-Age and she is vested with the power to sue and
be sued, contract and be contracted with, to buy, sell
and convey real estate generally to do and perform all
acts, which said minor could do if twenty-one years of age.
It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said
Olive Millstead pay the cost of this proceeding, for which
execution may issue.
