 Petition of Phine Millstead and Ex-Parte affidav-
 its of Simon Goldstein, J. R. White, J. H. Johnson and
 G. H. Moran, and the Court being of the opinion that it
 is, and will be, to the interest of said minor to be re-
 lieved of the disabilities of Non-Age, and upon Consider-
 ation thereof.

It is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that
 Phine Millstead, a minor, who is over the age of eighteen
 years, be, and she is hereby relieved of the disabilities of
 Non-Age, and she is vested with the power to sue and
 be sued, contract and be contracted with, to buy, sell
 and convey real estate generally to do and perform all
 acts, which said minor could do if twenty-one years of age.
 It is further ordered, adjudged, and decreed that the said
 Phine Millstead pay the cost of this proceeding, for which
 execution may issue.
