 of January A.D., 1871, between Jessie M. Rocco and Martha
 J. Rocco husband and wife, of the first part, and Joseph
 J. Gregg of the second part, witnesseth: That the said
 parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the
 sum of One hundred & thirty dollars to them in hand
 paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained &
 sold, and by their presents, do grant, bargain, sell
 and convey unto the said party of the second part
 the following described lands lying in Shelby County

State of Alabama. To wit: the NW¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄ of section nine, except that portion that lies north of the creek and also that portion of the SE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₂ of section eight lying South of the creek crossing the creek the line. In Township 20 of Range one East. to have, and to hold to second party, his heirs and assigns forever, the above described and hereby granted lands and premises. And the said parties of the first part, husband and wife, hereby covenant with the said parties of the second part that they are lawfully seized of, and have a good right to sell and convey, said lands, and hereby bind themselves, their heirs and legal representatives forever, to warrant and defend the title to said lands and premises to the said party of the second part, his heirs, assigns and legal representatives, against the claims of all and every person in law or equity, and against the Government of the United States.
