 poses and says, that he is General Manager of Kaul Lumber
 Company, and has been connected with said Company for
 15 years; that he is acquainted with the lands known
 and described as Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter and
 Northeast diagonal half of the Southeast Quarter of Southeast
 Quarter of Section 15, Township 18, Range 1 West, lying and

being situate in Jefferson County, Alabama, and also the Southwest diagonal half of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 15 - Township 18, Range 1 West, in Shelby County, Alabama; that said lands were purchased by Kaul Lumber Company from H.
