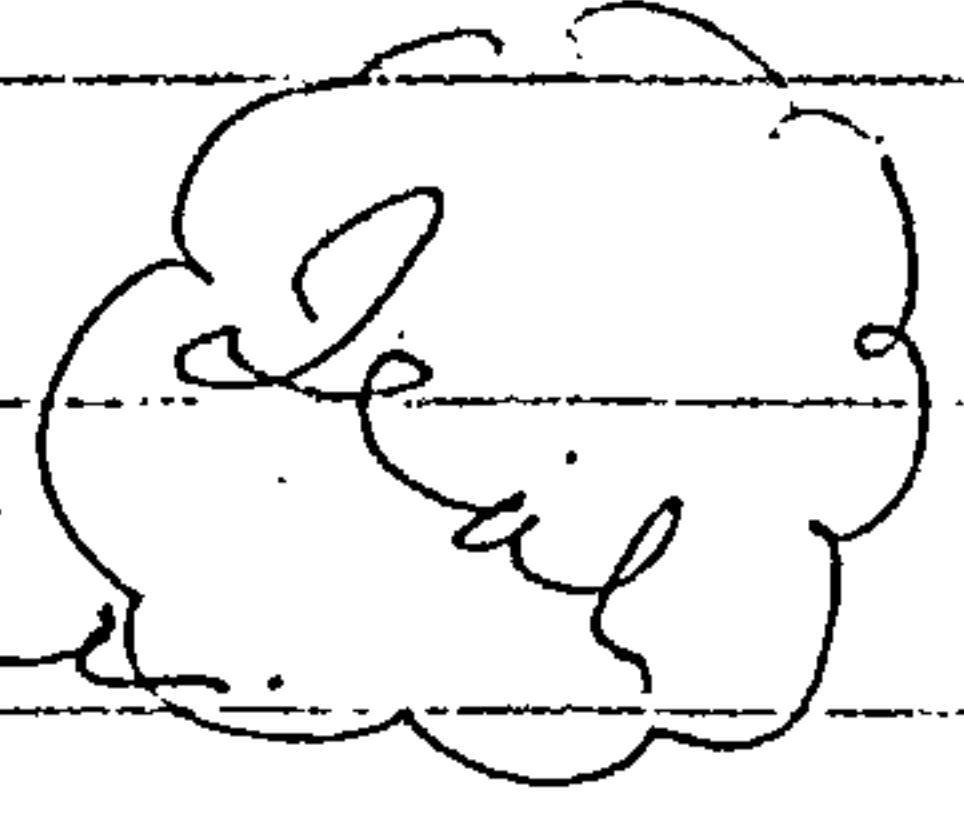


State of Alabama, } Before me, Geo. T. Roberts, a Notary Public
 Jefferson County, } in and for said County, in said
 State, personally appeared C. F. Lee, who, being duly sworn de-
 poses and says that on or about May 27, 1890, affiant and R.
 F. Cox purchased from Samuel M^cDawal the land known as
 West half of Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter of Section 8,
 Township 18, Range 1 West; and thereafter, on or about Jan. 12
 1905, affiant and said R. F. Cox conveyed said land
 by deed to Kaul Lumber Company; that said Samuel M^c-
 Dawal made deed to affiant and said R. F. Cox, or Cox &
 Lee, which deed was intended to convey the said West half
 of Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter, Section 8, Township
 18, Range 1 West, and if said deed of Samuel M^cDawal de-
 scribed the North half of Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter,
 instead of West half of said forty, this was due to a clerical
 error made in drafting the deed; that the said West half of
 said forty was intended to be conveyed in and by said deed,
 and that affiant and said Cox, upon securing said deed,
 took possession of said land to the extent same was capable
 of possession, going over the same frequently, looking after
 the same generally, paying taxes thereon, and being generally
 known and recognized as the owners; that said possession
 was continuous, open, notorious and adverse, under claim
 of ownership from the time said Cox and Lee acquired said
 lands from said Samuel M^cDawal until the same was sold
 to Kaul Lumber Company; and no other persons paid taxes
 or claimed to own the same; and the title of said Cox & Lee
 was never disputed; and said Cox & Lee remained in pos-
 session of said West half of said forty for a period of more
 than ten years, to the best of affiant's judgment and
 recollection.
