

Will of Sylvester Steele, Deceased.

I Sylvester Steele of the County of Jefferson in the State of Alabama, do hereby make, publish and declare my last will and testament in writing as follows.

- 1st. I wish all my just debts to be paid out of my estate.
- 2nd. I appoint my wife Margaret C. Steele my Executor who will act as such without bond and who will sell and dispose any and all my real and personal property at such times as she may deem best except my half interest in lot No. 99 fronting 25 feet on South side of 2nd ave. running back 100 feet the house upon said lot now being occupied by A. B. Vandegrift he and I being joint owners of said lot and house, the lot and house I give and will to my son George A. Steele with the understanding my wife Margaret C. Steele as executor will rent said house and lot and receive the rents therefor until my son George A. Steele shall become of full age or 21 years old which rents will be for her

individual use and not accountable for to any one as my executor.

3rd. I will and give to my wife Mrs. Hans and dollars out of any effects she may hold as my executor.

4th. I will and give to Sophia Vandegrift who is the child of A. B. Vandegrift (who is the child of my daughter Sophia Vandegrift) Five thousand dollars to be paid to her by my executor out of any effects she may dispose of to pay said sum of money.

5th. To my son George A. Steele I give all the remainder of my property not conveyed herebefore by this will.

Codicil

Vandegrift and my daughter Sophia Vandegrift) Twenty five hundred dollars to be paid to her by my executor out of any effects she may dispose of to pay said sum of money.
