Also all of the above described forty acres that lying Northwest of the public road leading to Dyke Mill. Also a part of the S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4, a part of the said forty acres West of J.L. Stout lot on the North side of the right-of-way of the East of Ga. R.R. being 23 acres more or less.
