 together with all mining equipment and property of every
 kind and description now being used in the operation of
 said mine, and particularly that certain lease dated
 the 31st day of Aug. 1917, and recorded in the office of
 the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Ala. in Deed Book 63
 pages 134-137, which said lease was heretofore transferred
 and assigned to the said R. E. McGee by transfer dated the

14th day of Dec. 1917, and recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Ala, in Book 63, page 123. As a part of the consideration of this conveyance, the Yellow Leaf Coal Company hereby agrees to assume that certain indebtedness owing by the said R. E.
