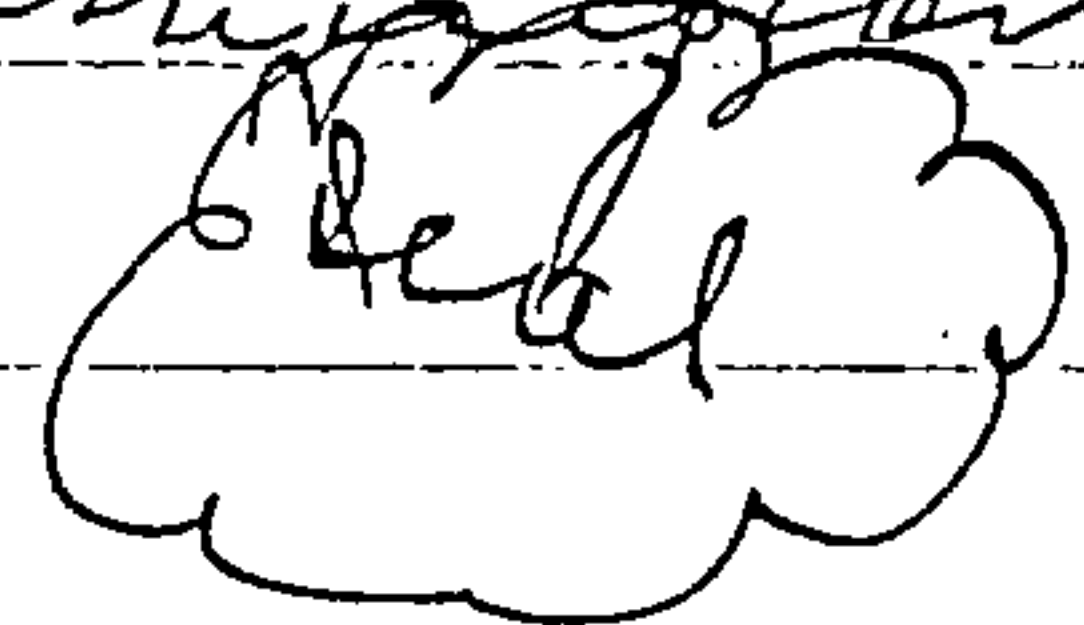

Whereas Samuel McBlanchard of Shelby County, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa in Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Samuel McBlanchard, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East Half of the South East Quarter of Section Thirteen in Township Twenty-two of Range One West, in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama, containing eighty acres and four hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel McBlanchard. Now know ye, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Samuel McBlanchard and his heirs the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Samuel McBlanchard and to his heirs and assigns forever.
