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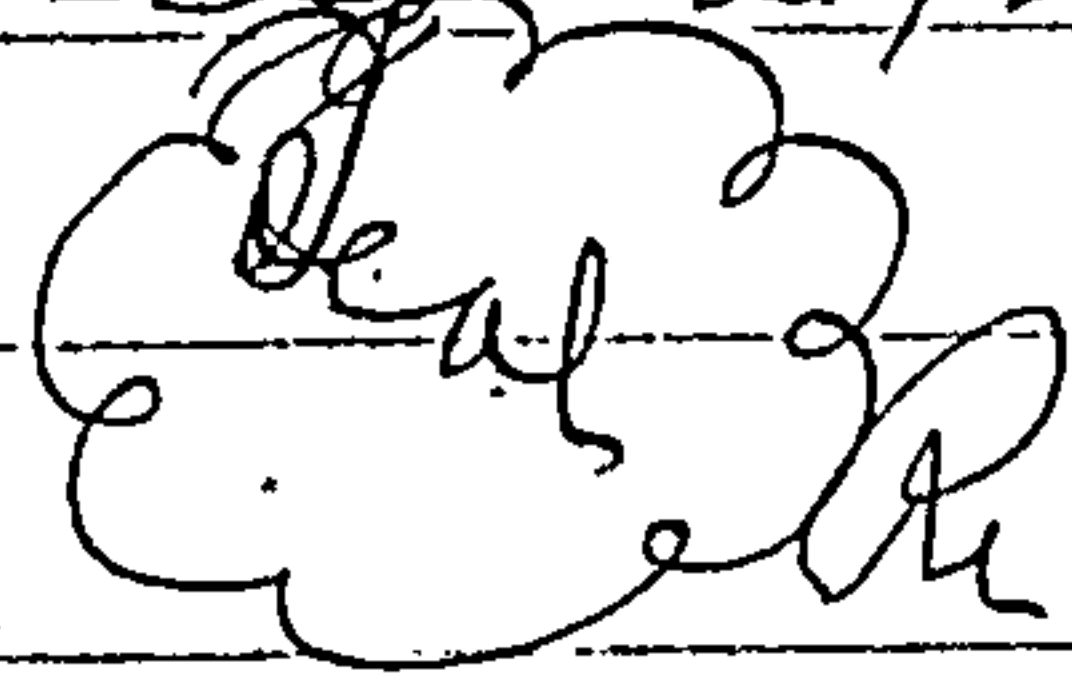

 To all to whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:
 Whereas Elsey H. Quinn of Shelby County, Alabama has depos-
 ited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Cer-
 tificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa
 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by
 the said Elsey H. Quinn according to the provisions of
 the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled,
 "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public
 Lands," for the South East Quarter of the South East Quar-
 der of Section Twenty-eight in Township Nineteen of Range
 Two East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tus-
 caloosa, Alabama, containing forty acres and two and
 a half hundredths of an acre, according to the survey
 of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office
 by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
 chased by the said Elsey H. Quinn.

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in Con-
 sideration of the Premises and in Conformity with the
 several acts of Congress, in such case made and pro-
 vided, Have Given and Grant, and by these presents
 Do Give and Grant unto the said Elsie H. Quinn
 and to her heirs the said tract above described:

To Have and To Hold the same, together with all the rights,
 privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever
 nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Elsey H.
 Quinn and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof I Martin Van Buren, President of
 the United States of America, have caused these Letters to
 be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office
 to be hereunto affixed.

 seventh day of November, in the Year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty seven, and of the
 Independence of the United States the fifty second.
