 Affiant further states that he has paid off and fully satis-
 fied said mortgage and has the same in his possession

marked paid: that owing to the said mortgage having been paid to Martha Aldridge and each of her children and they being so widely scattered it is almost impossible to obtain power of Attorney for the proper satisfaction of said mortgage as the margin of the record thereof.

Affiant further states that Thomas Aldridge was the husband of Martha Aldridge, she and her children spelling Aldridge, Arledge.

Affiant further states that his wife's maiden name was Nancy C. McClinton and she is one and the same person as H. C. McClinton, and is the same person taking by quit-claim deed from Minney Isabella Cost and her husband Geo. W. Cost deed dated December 13, 1887, and is one and the same person who took title to N. E 1/4 of S. E 1/4 of Section 19, T. 21, Range 1 East in Shelby County, Alabama, by warranty deed from E. B. McClinton, et al. dated January 10, 1899, said deed being recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Record 11, page 389.

Affiant further states that J. W. Cost who executed said deed with the other grantors herein is one and the same person as J. W. Cost whose estate is shown in this abstract to have been administered upon by R. F. Kirkland one of his heirs-in-law.

Affiant further states that the said H. C. McClinton or Nancy C. McClinton his said wife went into possession of said lands above described on said 10th day of January, 1889, and held the same openly, continuously, peaceably and adversely up to and until the 22nd day of December, 1906, when she conveyed the same to affiant, D. H. Webster.

Affiant further states that he held possession under said conveyance as did his wife before him and still holds possession under claim of ownership all of said lands above described except that part of the N. E 1/4 of S. E 1/4 of Section 19, T. 21, Range 1 East in Shelby County, Alabama, that lies North of the Columbian and Mardis Ferry Road. Affiant further states that G. H. Conville and M. H. Conville went into possession of said lands described last above on the 5th day of January, 1915, under a conveyance from affiant and have held the same as did

Nancy C. McClinton before me up to and including the date of the making of this affidavit.
