Together with all of the rights, privileges, easements, and subject to all of the conditions, limitations and restrictions contained in a certain deed, executed and delivered by Hanna McDannel to said Kaul Lumber Company, dated March 13, 1918 it being the intent of this conveyance to transfer and assign to said Betty & Sons Lumber Company all of the property, rights and privileges acquired by said Kaul Lumber Company from said Hanna McDannel.

To have and to hold unto the said Betty & Sons Lumber Company, its successors and assigns forever.

And the said Kaul Lumber Company, its successors and assigns, hereby covenants with the said Betty & Sons Lumber Company, its successors and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted rights and property; that the same are free from all incumbrances; that it has a good right to sell and convey the same unto the said Betty and Sons Lumber Company; and that it will forever warrant and defend the title to the above described rights and property, and the peaceful possession thereof, to the said Betty & Sons Lumber Company, its successors and assigns, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

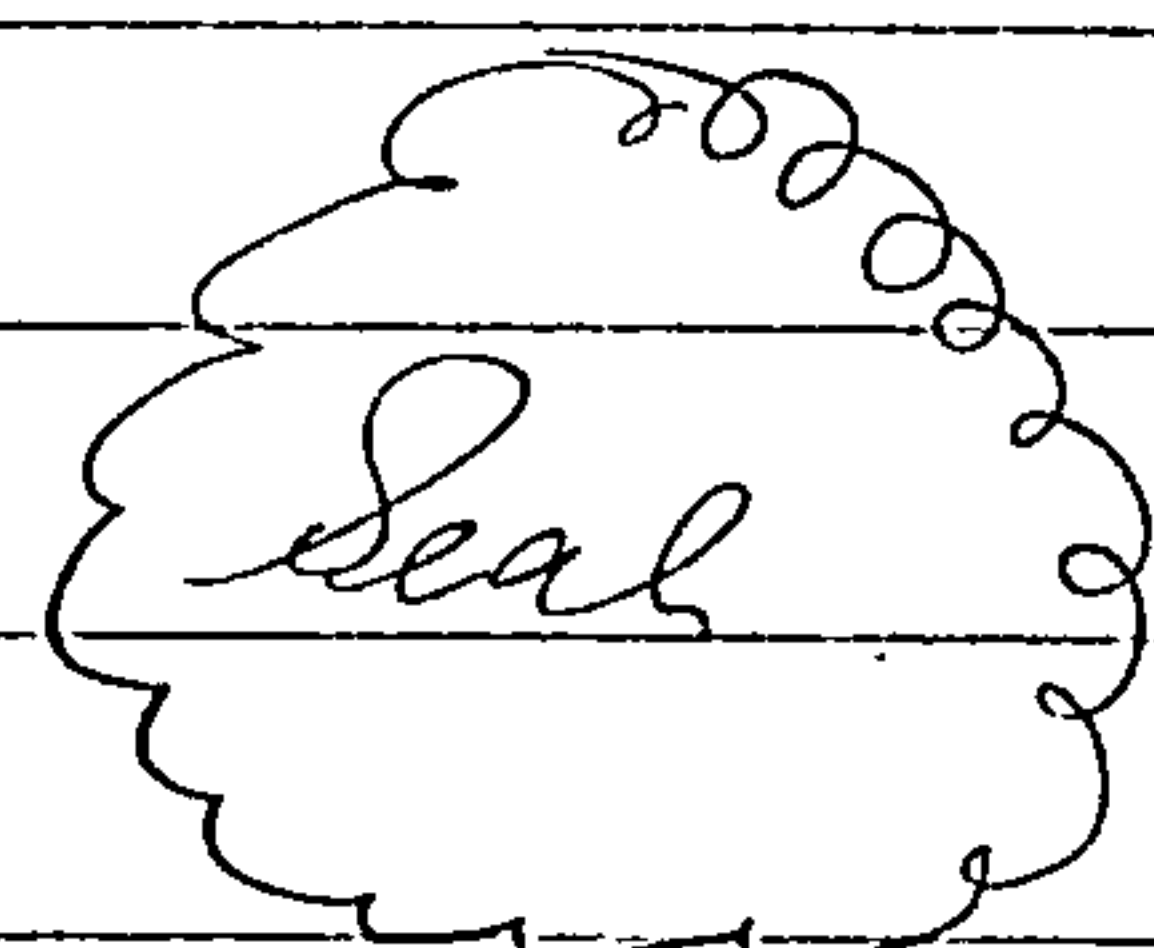
