To all to whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:

Whereas, Gaines Lee of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Gaines Lee, according to the provisions of an Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1870, entitled "An act making

for the provision for the sale of the Public Lands for the North East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section twenty eight, in Township eighteen of Range One West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing thirty nine acres and seventy-eight and a half hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Garrison Lee.

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the promises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Garrison Lee and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of what ever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Garrison Lee and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James Buchanan President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
