To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:
Whereas Samuel McDaniel has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery, Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Samuel McDaniel, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North West Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section Six in Township Nineteen South, of Range One West of the Huntsville Meridian, Alabama, containing thirty nine and eighty nine hundredths acres, according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said land, returned to the

General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel McDaniel:

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Samuel McDaniel and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, then unto belonging, unto the said Samuel McDaniel and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I Theodore Roosevelt President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the second day of August, in the year of our Lord nine thousand nine hundred and seven, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and thirty-second.
