Parker of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery, Alabama, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Lilburn H. Parker, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands" and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South half of the South West Quarter, the North West Quarter of the South West Quarter, and the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Thirty, in Township eighteen North, of Range One East at Huntsville Meridian in Alabama, containing one hundred and sixty-two acres and seventy two hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Lilburn H. Parker.
