Ex Parte - Mrs M. J. Johnson.

Petition for removal of the disabilities of Non-age of
 her son Nolan Johnson. May 15th. 1918.

This Cause coming on to be heard was submitted
 upon motion of the Petitioner for final decree upon the
 original petition, and the evidence of depositions of Nolan
 Kimbrel, Mrs M. J. Johnson and Thomas Murrey; in support
 thereof, as taken by reporter affidavit in accordance with
 the orders and directions of the Court and as noted
 by the Register; and the cause being fully understood
 and duly considered by the Court, and the Court
 finding that original petition was filed by Mrs M. J.
 Johnson, the mother of said minor, Nolan Johnson and
 with whom he is residing at Sylacauga, in Talladega
 County, Alabama, and the Court further finding that the
 father of the said Nolan Johnson is dead and that a

Copy of said original petition was served on said minor personally by the Sheriff of said County of Talladega and that said minor is fully developed mentally and qualified in every way to attend to his own business affairs; and the Court being satisfied and finding that it would be to the best interest of said minor, Nolan Johnson, who the Court finds was 18 years of age on the 11th day of August, 1917, to relieve him of his disabilities of Minor age, the Court is of the opinion that the petitioner is entitled to the relief prayed for. It is therefore considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that said minor, Nolan Johnson, be and he is hereby relieved from his disabilities of Minor age; and it is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that said Nolan Johnson shall be and he is hereby invested with full capacity, authority and right to sue and be sued, contract to buy, sell and convey real estate, and generally to do and transact any business and perform all acts which he, the said minor, could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age.

The Costs of the proceedings in this Cause are taxed against the petitioner for the Collection of which Let Execution issue.
