 who, being duly sworn, deposes and says on oath
 as follows: I am well acquainted with the real estate
 hereinafter described. I have been living in the com-
 munity where the same is located for 22 years. I
 remember the time when this property was sold to
 Martin T. Donothens by R. A. O'Hara and wife which
 was in the fall of the year 1904. A portion of this
 property has been in actual cultivation to my
 personal knowledge each year since Martin T.
 Donothens bought it from the said R. A. O'Hara and
 wife and the persons who cultivated the land
 each year each did so recognizing and ac-
 knowledging that the land belonged to no other
 person except Martin T. Donothens until during the
 year 1914 at which time Martin T. Donothens and
 husband sold this land together with other land
 to J. H. Guell and C. M. Smith and since 1914

the land has been cultivated such years as the land belonged to no other person except the said J. H. Guill and C. M. Smith. No one has ever questioned or disputed that the land described above belonged to Mattie K. Bonothers from the time she bought the same in 1904 until she sold it to J. H. Guill and C. M. Smith in 1914, and no one has disputed the fact or questioned the fact that the said J. H. Guill and C. M. Smith has owned the said land since during the year 1914, when they purchased the same from the said Mattie K. Bonothers.

As a matter of fact to my knowledge a portion of this land has been in actual cultivation for more than 30 years previous to this date the said land being situated in Shelby County, State of Alabama and described as follows: a strip of land 210 yards wide off of the North end of the S. E. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 of Section 26, and a part of the N. 1/2 of the N. E. 1/4 of said Section 26 described as follows: Beginning 210 yards South of the Northwest Corner of the S. W. 1/4 of the N. E. 1/4 of said Section 26 and running in the North-east direction to the Center of the North boundary line of said S. W. 1/4 of N. E. 1/4 of said Section, thence running in a Northerly direction along a made line to Wilsonville Public Road, thence running West to the Northwest Corner of the N. W. 1/4 of the N.
