Know all men by these presents That, I, Mrs. O. L. Gorman for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by N. D. Raley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I do grant bargain sell and convey unto said N. D. Raley all of the pine timber on the following described lands that will measure from 10 inches up outside of plantation to wit $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, All in Section 31, T. 18, Range 3 East, also NW $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 6 T. 19, Range 3 East, also part of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T. 19, Range 2 East. It is also agreed that if by any error said N. D. Raley shall be prevented from cutting any part of this timber, I obligate myself to refund to him an amount that will be in proportion per acre of amt. for the timber

To have and to hold to said N. D. Raley his heirs and assigns
 the above described timber on said lands, & bind myself
 my heirs and legal representatives to warrant and defend
 the same to said N. D. Raley his heirs and assigns, it is
 agreed that this timber shall be cut off in not longer time
