Freeman, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to each of us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by J. M. Thomas, have remised, released, and quit-claimed, and do, hereby, remise, release, quit-claim and convey unto said J. M. Thomas, the following described real estate lying and being in said Shelby County, State of Alabama, to-wit:

The $\frac{N}{2}$ of $N\frac{E}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 22, South, Range 3 West excepting such rights and encumbrances as the public are legally entitled to in the highway known as the Columbus and Tuscaloosa public road, along the south end of said land, to have and to hold, the aforegranted premises unto the said J. M. Thomas, his heirs and assigns forever.

The purpose and intention of this conveyance is to convey to said J. M. Thomas, his heirs and assigns, certain strips of said land, across the north end and along the east side, thereof, which were reserved and excepted by said G. W. Freeman in a deed of conveyance heretofore, to-wit, on the 10 day of October, 1908, made by himself and his then wife to said J. M. Thomas, and which deed is recorded in deed book 39, Page 414 deed Records of said Shelby County, at the time of said sale and conveyance it seemed probable that roadways have not been opened, adapted, or in any way dedicated, and it is not now considered desirable to use said strips of land, which are now enclosed and under cultivation by said J. M. Thomas, and should be, and are hereby conveyed so as to give the said J. M. Thomas, his heirs and assigns a fee simple title to the whole of said $\frac{N}{2}$ of $N\frac{E}{4}$, except such as may be covered by the Columbus and Tuscaloosa public road. And we hereby certify that no part of the above described land constitutes any part of the homestead of the grantors herein.
