

The State of Alabama } Know all men by these Presents:
 Shelby County. } that we, G. H. Freeman and Lodie C.
 Freeman, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum
 of one dollar to each of us in hand paid by W. H.
 Williams, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have promised, released, and quit-claimed and do
 hereby promise, release, quit-claim and convey unto
 said W. H. Williams, the following described real es-
 tate lying and being in the County of Shelby, State
 of Alabama, to-wit: The E 1/2 of S. W. 1/4 and N 1/2 of S. E 1/4
 and the S. E 1/4 of the S. E 1/4 of Section 33 and the S. W 1/4 of
 S. W 1/4 of Section 34 Township 21, Range 3 West except-
 ing so much of said land as may lie West of the
 East line of the Mantallos and Elyton road.
 To have and to hold unto said W. H. Williams, his
 heirs and assigns forever.

The purpose and intention of this conveyance is to
 convey to said W. H. Williams and his assigns, cer-
 tain strips of land which were reserved and ex-
 cepted by said G. H. Freeman in a deed of convey-
 ance heretofore, or, to-wit, the 19th day of October, 1908,
 to said W. H. Williams describing the aforementioned
 lands and, which deed is recorded in Deed Book
 39, page 329, Deed Records of said ^{Shelby} County, Alabama.
 At the time of said sale and conveyance it seemed
 probable that roadways might be desirable as therein
 contemplated; but such roadways have not been
 opened or adopted and no dedication of the same has
 been made and it now is not considered advisa-
 ble or desirable to use such strips of land as road-
 ways, and which are now, in fact, enclosed and
 cultivated, and should be and are hereby conveyed
 so as to give the said W. H. Williams and his assigns
 a fee simple title to the whole of said subdivi-
 sion hereinbefore described.
