 Jefferson County. That, Whereas, on to-wit, the last
 day of July, 1914, Cusheba Coal Company, a Corporation
 organized under the laws of the State of Alabama,
 issued its negotiable bonds aggregately in amount
 the sum of fifty thousand dollars, said bonds be-
 ing in the denomination of one thousand dollars
 each, and, to secure the payment thereof, executed
 a mortgage or deed of trust to the Worcester Trust Com-
 pany, of Worcester, Mass., a Corporation, as Trustees,
 conveying certain real estate, situated in Shelby County,
 Alabama, as well as certain personal property located
 on said real estate, which mortgage or deed of trust
 was recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of
 Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Record 109, Page 1,
 after the same had been so executed by the said
 Cusheba Coal Company, and after the trust created
 by the said instrument had been duly accepted
 by the said Worcester Trust Company, and

Whereas, subsequent to the execution and re-
 cording of said instrument the said Worcester Trust
 Company, in accordance with the provisions contained
 in the said instrument, resigned as such Trustees
 and was discharged from the said trust, and the
 undersigned H. M. Hoke of Birmingham, Alabama,
 was duly appointed and designated as successor of
 the said Worcester Trust Company, as such Trustee,
 in accordance with the provisions and terms of said
 instrument, which Trusteeship was duly accepted by
 the said H. M. Hoke, all as evidenced by certain
 instrument made and executed on the 20th day
 of July, 1917, and duly recorded in the Office of
 the Probate Judge of Shelby, Alabama, in Deed Record
 61, Page 382. And

Whereas, satisfactory proof has been made to the said
 H. M. Hoke, as such Trustee, that all the indebted-
 ness secured by the said mortgage or deed of trust
 has been paid and all the bonds and the Com-
 pany duly cancelled and satisfied, have been
 exhibited to the said H. M. Hoke by the said

Eureka Coal Company, and request has been made of the said H. M. Woke, as such Trustee by the said Eureka Coal Company, to execute this instrument of release and to cause the said Mortgage or deed of Trust to be satisfied and cancelled of record. Now then, in consideration of the premises, I, the said H. M. Woke, as substituted Trustee under the said Mortgage or deed of Trust hereby declare that the indebtedness secured by the said Mortgage or deed of Trust has been fully paid and satisfied; and that the lien of the said mortgage is discharged; and that the property conveyed by the said mortgage or deed of Trust is released from the lien created by the said instrument. And I hereby authorize and empower B. N. Kiser, the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, to enter, on the margin of the record of said mortgage or deed of Trust, in the said Probate Office, that the deed secured by the said mortgage or deed of Trust has been paid and that the said mortgage or deed of Trust is cancelled and satisfied. Hereby ratifying and confirming whatever he, the said B. N. Kiser, as my attorney in fact, may lawfully do in the premises. In Witness Whereof, I, the said H. M.
