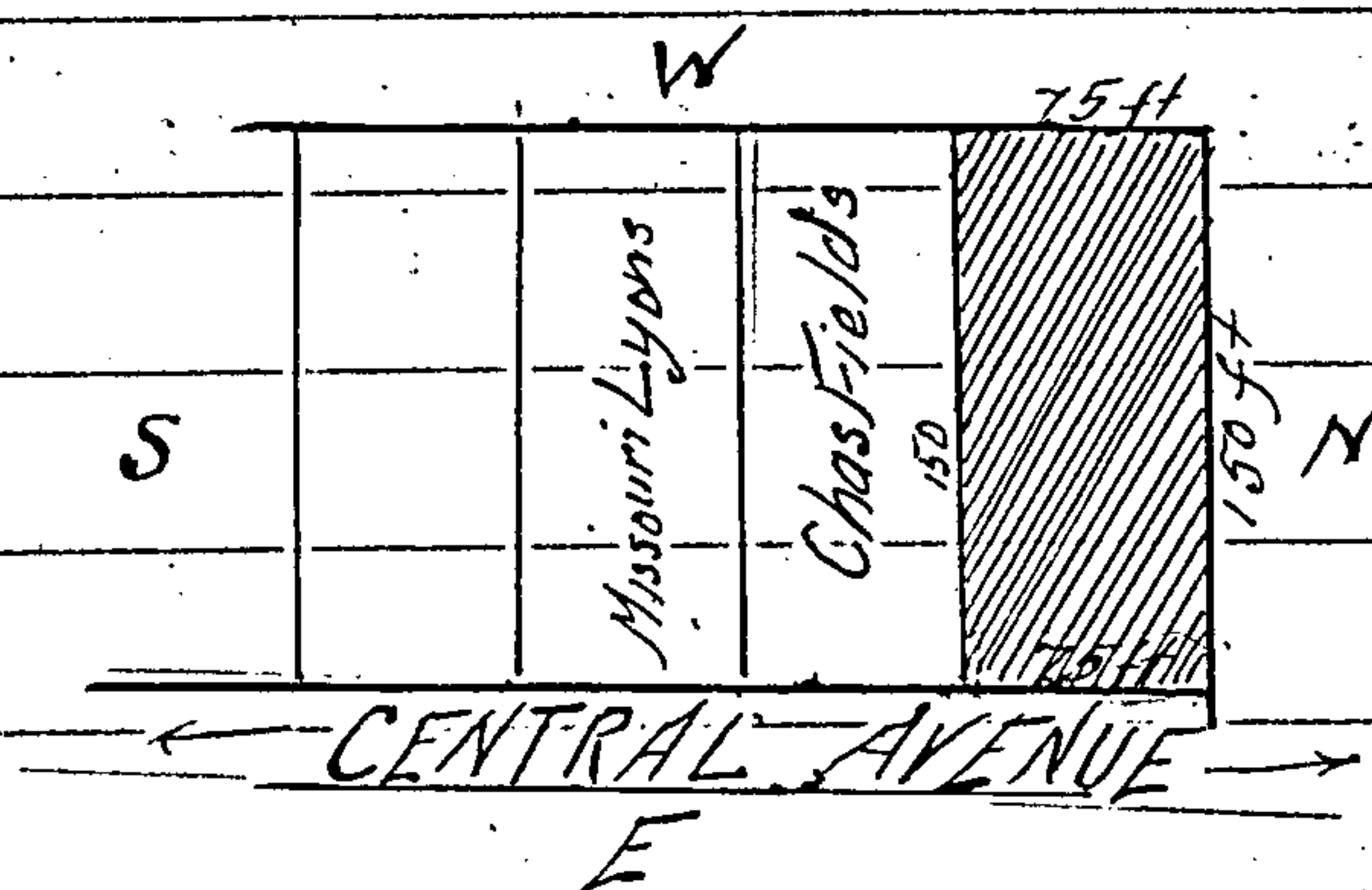


State of Alabama Know all men by these Presents,

 East corner of said lot, thence along the Western bound-
 ary line of Central Avenue (so called) seventy-five (75)
