
Know All men by these Presents:
That the Alabama Mineral Land Company, a Corporation

granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents

 that is, timber which is ten (10) inches or more in
 diameter outside the bark at the stump or base,
 measured two feet above the ground, on Northeast
 Quarter of Southwest Quarter, South half of Southwest
 Quarter, and Southeast Quarter of Section No. 19,
 Township Twenty One (21) South, Range One (1) East, con-
 taining two Hundred Seventy-eight $\frac{57}{100}$ (278.57)
 acres more or less, in Shelby County, State of Alabama,
 subject to the conditions, agreements and covenants
 hereof, to-wit: The cutting of said saw timber may
 commence at once; and must be completed within
 twenty-eight (28) months from this date, and which
 has not been so cut and removed within said
 time shall revert to and become the property of the
 grantor; and occupancy of said land by said
 grantee is expressly limited to the time needed to
 cut said saw timber but not beyond the time
 stated, and for the purpose of cutting said saw
 timber only, and all rights on said land shall
 cease as soon as said timber has been cut and
 removed; and grantee may remove houses
 and machinery put on said land, if they are
 so removed within the time allowed for cutting
 and removing said timber.
