Fancher the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said A. M. Cross and Ella J. Cross do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Sallie L. Fancher the following described Real Estate, to-wit:

Commencing at a point eight hundred and thirty five feet on the West side of the Marshall road, same dirt road, from where said road crosses railway to the right of way of the Southern Railway Company's rail road, said point of commencement being South west of said intersection of said Right of Way, Service running南北, said road also of said Right of Way, two hundred and fifty feet to the left (210) - whence North West to the intersection of running North and South dividing section line in County Line Twenty four (24) Range & twelve (12) East, whence North along section line to said Southern Railway Company's Right of Way, whence in an Easterly direction along said Right of Way about one hundred feet (100) to the corner of the lot this day sold to Sallie L.
