*A part of a certain lot in the town of Milledgeville, which was heretofore known as and called the "Morgan Stone Lot," the said part hereby conveyed being a part of lot no. 14, according to the original plan of said town, as recorded in the office of the probate judge of said Shelby County, and is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the northwest margin of Broad Street, sometimes called "Market Street," one hundred seven (107) feet eight (8) inches northeast of the most southerly corner of the block on which said lot no. 14 is situated, said point of beginning being the easternmost corner of the C. L. Meroney Stone Lot - running thence in a northeasterly direction, along the margin of Broad Street, a distance of twenty-five and one-half (25 1/2) feet, thence northerly, perpendicular to said Broad Street, to the southern margin of Valley Street, a distance of three hundred (300) feet, more or less, thence southwesterly, along said Valley Street, a distance of twenty-five and one-half (25 1/2) feet, thence southwesterly, three hundred (300) feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; the same being a parallelogram in form adjoining the C. L. Meroney Stone Lot on the northeast side thereof, fronting 25 1/2 feet on Broad Street and running back in uniform width, to Valley Street,*
