KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That for and in consideration of Twelve hundred fifty 09/10th 1920 DOLLARS,

to the undersigned Grantor G. J. Truell in hand paid by U. E. Beasley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we the said G. J. Truell and S. F. Truell, his wife, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said U. E. Beasley

the following described Real Estate, to-wit:

A Certain lot in the town of Wilton particularly described as follows; Beginning at a point on the Northwest margin of the Montevallo and Wilton public road which is four hundred forty-three (443) feet Northeast from the intersection of said Northwest line of said road with the South line of the N. W. 1/4 of Section nine (9), Township twenty-four (24) North, Range twelve (12) East, or a Westward prolongation of said last mentioned line - the said point of beginning being the Southermost Corner of a Certain lot conveyed by Theo Kuffer to George Truell by deed dated March 26th. 1917, and recorded in Deed Book 59, page 609, in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelly County, Alabama, and which said deed is hereby referred to for all purposes of description of the lot hereby conveyed. From said point of beginning run Northwest, along the line of said George Truell lot, one hundred forty four (144) feet, to the Westernmost Corner of said George Truell lot, said point being six feet east of the easterly line of what is called the "Cherry Lot" and which east line is marked by a ditch; thence Southwardly, parallel with the easterly line of said "Cherry Lot" and six feet equidistant therefrom, eighty four (84) feet, thence Southwesterly, one hundred eighteen (118) feet, to a point on the said Northwest margin of said Montevallo and Wilton public road, which is eighty two (82) feet Southwest of the point of beginning of the lot hereby conveyed, and thence Northwest along the said margin of said road, to said point of beginning, the same being a part of the premises conveyed by Theo Kuffer to said G.
