

Certificate The United States of America,  
 No. 126045 To all to whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:  
 Whereas, Edmund King of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited  
 in the General Land Office of the United States, a Certificate of  
 the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it ap-  
 pears that full payment has been made by the said Edmund  
 King, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of  
 the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further  
 provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South-  
 west Quarter of the South West Quarter, of Section Two, in Town-  
 ship Twenty-Six, of Range Thirteen East, in the District of  
 Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing  
 forty acres and six and one fourth hundredths of an acre,  
 according to the official plan of the Survey of the said lands,  
 returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor Gen-  
 eral, which said tract has been purchased by the said  
 Edmund King.

Now Know ye, that the United States of America, in Consideration  
 of the Premises, and in Conformity with the several acts of Congress  
 in such case made and provided, have given and Granted,  
 and by these presents do Give and Grant unto the said  
 Edmund King and to his heirs, the said tract above de-  
 scribed: To have and to hold the same, together with all  
 the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of  
 whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said  
 Edmund King and to his heirs and assigns forever.  
 In Testimony whereof, I, Millard Fillmore, President of the  
 United States of America, have caused these Letters to be  
 made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to  
 be hereunto affixed.

 day of January, in the Year of Our Lord, one thousand  
 eight hundred and fifty-two and of the Independence

of the Registered States the Twenty Sixth.
