Thomas Daniel Threatt of Shelby County, Alabama has purchased in
 the United States a certain tract of land, office of the General Land Office, whereby
 the General Land Office has been made to pay to the said Daniel Threatt, which said
 tract has been purchased by the said Daniel Threatt.
 Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration
 of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts
 of Congress, in such case made and provided, do give
 and grant, and by these presents do give and grant
 unto the said Daniel Threatt, and to his heirs, the
 said tract above described: To have and to hold the
 same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and
 appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto
 the said Daniel Threatt and to his heirs and assigns forever,
 in testimony whereof, I, Franklin Pierce, President of the
 United States of America, have caused these letters to be
 made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be
 affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the first
 day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight
 hundred and fifty three, and of the dependencies of the
 United States the Seventy eighth.
