Sheeky County, for said County and State, personally  
appeared E. G. Turner Jr., (60 years old), who is known to me  
and who being by me first duly sworn, doth oath deposes  
and says that for the past 20 years he has been familiar  
with the following described land situated in Sheeky County,  
Alabama, to-wit: The Southeast Quarter of the Northeast  
Quarter of section 33 (except the East 10 acres thereof and  
also about 5 acres in the Northwest corner thereof now  
owned by D. G. Justice) Township 18, Range 2 East, the East  
half of the Southeast Quarter of said section (except a two  
acre tract in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter  
of said section described in deed from Ida Elliott and  
husband to T. M. Jackson recorded in the Probate Office

of said County, in Deed Book 56, on page 503) and the North  
ten acres of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter  
of Section 3, Township 19, Range 2 East, being part of the lands now
