

State of Alabama ; Know all men by these Presents
County of Jefferson,} That, in consideration of the
conveyance by the Tennessee Coal, Iron
and railroad Company to the Southern mineral
land Company by Deed bearing even date
hereof of certain land and interests in land
located in Shelby County, Alabama, and
specifically described in said Deed; and in
further consideration of one dollar (\$1.00), to the Southern
mineral land Company, in hand Paid by the
Tennessee Coal Iron and Railroad Company, receipt
Whereof is acknowledged the said Southern mineral land
Company does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey
unto the said Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company
the following described land and interests in land
located in Shelby and Bibb Counties, Alabama,
Excepting such rights of way or easements for railroads,
tramroads, electric transmission lines, telephone lines
and public highways as are now owned by the
grantor herein; this conveyance being expressly subject
to all such rights of way and easements:

(1) the following described land located in Township
21 south of Range 3 and west of the Huntsville
Principal Meridian, Shelby County : an undivided two-
thirds interest in the South half of South-East Quarter of Section
6, Township 21 south of range 3 west; the South-East quarter of
North-East quarter, an undivided two-thirds interest in the
North-West quarter, and undivided one-third interest in the
South-West quarter of South-West quarter and in the North-
West quarter of South-East quarter; all of said land being located
in Section 7, Township 21 south of range 3 west; the West half

of north-west quarter of section 8, township 21 south of range 3 West; an undivided two-thirds interest in the south half of north-east quarter of section 12, township 21, south of Range 4 West; reserving and excepting, however, from this conveyance under Paragraph (1) the seam of coal known as montevello No. 3 seam, together with the right to mine and remove said coal, which is the same seam now being mined at the strawbs mine; (2) the following described land located in township 21, south of Range 4 West of the Huntsville Principal meridian, Shelby County: an undivided one-third interest in the south half of south-west quarter of section 10; the north half of north-west quarter and the south west diagonal half of south-west quarter of section 13; the south-east quarter of north-east quarter, the north half of north-west quarter, the south-west quarter, of north-west quarter, the north-east quarter of south-east quarter, and the south half of south-east quarter, all of said land being located in section 15; and undivided one-third interest in the north-west quarter of section 22; an undivided one-third interest in the north half of north-west quarter and in the south-west quarter of north-west quarters, all of said land being located in section 28; the north-west quarter of south-east quarter, the south half of south-east quarter of south-east quarter, all that part of the north-east-quarter of south-east quarter lying north of center of antioch-marvel Public Road, all of said land being located in section 32; the south-east quarter of north-west quarter, the east half of south-west quarter, of south-west quarter, and the north half of south-east quarters, all of said land being located in section 33; the north half of north-east quarter of section 34; the north-west diagonal half of south half of north-east quarter and north-west diagonal half of south-west quarter, all of said land being located in section 35; (3) all the coal and other minerals in, under and upon the following described land located in township 21, south of range 4 West of the Huntsville Principal meridian, Shelby County: the west half of west half of south-west quarter of section 25; the south half of south-east quarter of section 26; the south-east quarter of south-west quarter of section 28; the north half of south-east quarter of south-east quarter, all that part of the north-east quarter

of South-East quarter south of Public Road running from antiseast to marble, all of said land being located in Section 32; the North-East Quarter of North-West Quarter and West half of South-West Quarter of South-West Quarter, all of said land being located in Section 33; the North-East Quarter of North-East Quarter of Section 35; together with the right to mine and remove said coal and other minerals, and also the right to build roads of any description over said land necessary for the convenient transportation of coal and other minerals from said land and other land and for the conveying and transporting to and from said land all material and implements that may be useful in mining and removing said coal and other minerals; (4) the West half of North-West Quarter of North-East Quarter and the West half of East half of North-West Quarter of North-East Quarter of Section 13, Township 21 South of Range 4 West of the Huntsville Principal meridian, Shelby County; reserving and excepting, however, from this conveyance of land under Paragraph (4) all the coal and other minerals in, under and upon said land, together with the right to mine and remove said coal and other minerals, and also the right to build roads of any description over said land necessary for the convenient transportation of coal and other minerals from said land and other land and for the conveying and transporting to and from said land all material and implements that may be useful in mining and removing said coal and other minerals; (5) the South-West Quarter of South-East Quarter of Section 32, Township 21 South of Range 4 West of the Huntsville Principal meridian, Bibb County; to have and to hold unto the said Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, forever. And the Southern Mineral Land Company, its successors and assigns covenants with the Tennessee Coal, Iron and Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, that it, the Southern Mineral Land Company, is lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that it has a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that it will and its successors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same to the said Tennessee Coal,

Iron and Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, forever against the lawful claims of all Persons. And for the considerations hereinbefore expressed the said southern mineral land Company does hereby remise, release, quit-claim and convey unto the said Tennessee coal, iron and Railroad Company any right, title, interest or claim other than that hereinbefore conveyed in and to the land described in Paragraph three; to have and to hold unto the said Tennessee coal, iron and Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, forever. 


