I know all men by these Presents, That I
 S.M. Folley a married man and the head of a
 family, and a resident citizen of Shelby County,
 Alabama, do hereby claim as exempt to me
 from levy and sale under any process, the
 following property, to wit: Ten acres being a
 strip of equal width across West side of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$
 of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, also the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, and N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$
 and S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, except 5 acres in the North West
 corner of said forty acres, all of said land in
 Section 34, Township 21 Range 4 West containing 125
 acres more or less, all in Shelby County, Alabama
 and of less than \$2000.00 in value and less than
 160 acres in area, said above described land
 being the homestead on which I and my
 family now reside.
