I now declare by these Presents, that I S.M. Lawley a married man and the head of a family, and a resident citizen of Shelby County, Alabama, do hereby claim as exempt to me from levy and sale under any process, the following property, to wit: Ten acres being a strip of equal width across West Side of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, also the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$, and N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ except 5 acres in the North West Corner of said forty acres, all of said land in Section 34 Township 21 Range 4 West containing 125 acres more or less, all in Shelby County, Alabama, and of less than \$2000.00 in value and less than 160 acres in area, said above described land being the homestead on which I and my family now reside.
