Jones, George Jones and his wife Annie Jones for and, in consideration of the sum of Twenty five & no/100 Dollars (\$25.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a Corporation, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon a strip of land one hundred feet in width, as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretofore made by said Company, over and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and dumper trees adjacent thereto where necessary.

Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

North-East Quarter of South-East Quarter, Section 23, Township 24 N. Range 15 East.

Said strip is substantially described as follows: Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuation thereof; Commence at a point on the South boundary of said Section 23, said point being West 1044.3 feet from the South East corner of said Section 23, thence running North 8 degrees 02 minutes West for a distance of 1334.7 feet to a point on the South boundary of said North East Quarter of South East Quarter, of said Section 23, which is the point of beginning. From said point of beginning, running North 8 degrees 02 minutes West for a distance of 1339 feet more or less to a point on the North boundary of said North East Quarter of South-East Quarter of said Section 23.

To Have and to hold the same to the said Company,

its successors and assigns forever.

The grantors shall have the right to cultivate and use said strip of land for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights which the grantee may from time to time exercise hereunder.
