W. W. Batten and his wife May Batten, Jr.  
and in consideration of the sum of thirty seven  $\frac{5}{10}$  dollars (\$37 $\frac{5}{10}$ ) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company  
a Corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do  
hereby grant to said company, its successors and assigns,  
the right to construct, operate and maintain electric  
transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone  
lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or con-  
venient in connection therewith from time to time upon  
a strip of land one hundred feet in width, as said  
strip is now located by the final location survey there-  
fore made by said Company, over and across the  
the land which it is herein after described as being  
a part, together with all the right and privileges need-  
ful or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof  
for the purpose above described, including the right  
of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the  
right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth  
and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees  
adjacent thereto where necessary.

Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated  
in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:  
Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter of section  
18 township 18 range 1 east.

Said strip is substantially described as follows:  
Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuation  
thereof. Commence at a point on the north boundary of  
said section 18 said point being west 212.22 feet  
from North East corner of said section 18 thence

running south 3 degrees 6 minutes east for a distance  
of 260.6 feet to a point on north boundary of said  
northwest quarter of south east quarter of said  
Section 18 which is the point of beginning from  
said point of beginning run south 3 degrees 6 minutes  
east for a distance of 1326 feet more or less to  
a point on south boundary of said northwest quarter  
of south east quarter of said Section 18.  
to have and to hold the same to the said  
Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

The grantees shall have the right to cultivate  
and use said strip of land for any purpose not  
inconsistent with the rights which the grantees  
may from time to time exercise hereunder.


