

State of Arkansas Right of way for Public Roads
 Shelby County }

I know all men by these presents, that we, the undersigned, S. O. Barden and Fuley Barden, of the State and County aforesaid, in and for the consideration of one \$1000 in hand paid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits accruing to us and to the farm the construction of a public road through our lands, we do hereby give, grant, bargain and convey unto Shelby County, its successors, a right of way hereinafter described, over and across the lands of the undersigned for a public road: Which right of way shall be fifty (50) feet in width or 25 feet in width on each side of the center line of said road as it is now located and shown out by the State Highway Department ~~or~~ designated as F. A. P. #99, or as much of any land as is required to make a 50 foot right of way, across any lands which are located and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the intersection of the east line on the $\frac{SE}{4}$ of the $\frac{SE}{4}$ of section 2, Township 21, N. & Range 3. E. and the center line of the said road, thence along a 1^{st} curve to the right 1122 feet more or less to the point of tangency of said curve, thence north $0^{\circ} 13'$ East, 490 feet more or less to the point of a 2^{nd} 48' curve to the left thence along said curve.

4.12 feet more or less to the intersection of the North line of the NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄ of Section 2, Township 21.5 Range 24.5, and the Center line of said Road, the above described tract of land, lying in the SE¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄ and in the NE¹/₄ of the SE¹/₄, all in Section 2 Township 21.5 Range 24.5 Shelly County and containing 2.27 acres more or less and for and Consideration of the benefits to our property by reason of the construction of said Road, we hereby release the County, from all Consequential Damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the Construction, Maintenance or repair of said Road, and that said Road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
