the petition of Scott County Milling
Company for a rule nisi directed to
W. L. Baldwin, Will V. Connell and Connell
Baldwin, a partnership formerly com-
posed of W. L. Baldwin and Will V. Connell
requiring them and each of them to
be and appear in this court on a day
certain and propound any claim which
they or either of them have, or might
have in and to that certain indebted-
ness evidenced by mortgage and note
or notes executed by H. W. Williams
to Connell Baldwin, on to wit December
1st 1919, and recorded in the office of
Judge of Probate of Shelby County in
Mortgage Record Volume 137 Page 299 on
to wit January 17, 1920 for the sum of
Two Thousand dollars as well as any
right title interest or claim, which they
or either of them have or might
have in and to the property described
in said mortgage and further re-
quiring the said respondents W. L. Bal-
win and Will V. Connell and Connell
Baldwin a partnership, to show
cause if any they have, why the
title to said mortgage and the
property therein described and the
indebtedness thereby secured should
not vest in Chas. T. Wicken, as Trustee in

bankruptcy of the estate of Will V.
 Cornell Company, and sold as part
 of the assets of the said Will V.
 Cornell Company, a bankrupt, And it
 appearing to the Court that all parties
 have had due notice of said petition for
 rule nisi, and said parties appear-
 ing and disclaiming any right title
 interest or claim in and to the
 said mortgage indebtedness and the
 property described in said mortgage
 and it further appearing to the Court
 on satisfactory evidence that the
 said debt together with the property
 securing the same belongs to and
 forms a part of the estate of the
 said Will V. Cornell Company a bank-
 rupt, and it being shown to the
 Court that there now remains
 due and unpaid on said mortgage
 debt the sum of \$26.50 from R. W.
 Williams to the said Will V. Cornell
 Company, and the Scott County Mill-
 ing Company, appearing in open Court
 and offering to purchase said mort-
 gage indebtedness as well as the
 property securing the same as named
 and described in said mortgage afore-
 said, and bidding for the same
 the sum of \$26.50 it is thereupon
 on the motion of the trustee no
 adverse interest appearing by the Court.
 Considered, Ordered and decreed as
 follows:

1. That all of the right title and
 interest and claim of W. H. Baldwin
 Will V. Cornell Company Baldwin, a par-
 tnership, if any they had, in and to the
 said mortgage indebtedness and the
 note and notes evidencing said debt

edness as well as any right title interest and claim in and to the property described in said mortgage, he and the same is hereby divested out of said W S Baldwin Will V. Cornell and Cornell-Baldwin, a partnership and the title to the same is hereby vested in Chas F. Willen as trustee in Bankruptcy of the estate of Will V. Cornell Company, a Bankrupt

2. The Court ascertains from the evidence in the case that there remains due and unpaid on said mortgage above described the sum of \$26.50

3. That the bid of the Scott County Milling Company, he and the same is accepted and the trustee will by appropriate conveyance convey to the said Scott County Milling Company without recourse all his right title interest and claims to said mortgage indebtedness as evidenced by said mortgage and notes aforesaid as well as the property covered by said mortgage and described therein
