NOW THEREFORE, Central Union Trust Company of New York, (formerly called Central Trust Company of New York) as trustee under said mortgage, does hereby designate and appoint D. O. Hill, of Jefferson County, Alabama, its true and lawful agent and attorney in fact for it and in its name and stead to enter the fact of payment and full satisfaction on the margin of the record of said mortgage in the offices of the Judges of Probate of Bibb, Jefferson and Shelby Counties, in the State of Alabama, hereby ratifying and confirming whatsoever its attorney may lawfully do in the premises; and

Said Central Union Trust Company of New York, as trustee under said mortgage of Cahaba Coal Mining Company, dated December 1, 1892, (and not otherwise) does hereby remise, release, quit claim and convey unto the Tennessee Coal, Iron and mailroad Company, successor in title to the Cahaba coal Mining Company and right, title or interest which it acquired or may now have in or to any or all of the property conveyed to it, as trustee, by said mortgage.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Tennessee, Coal, Iron and Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
