Said portions of said streets and alleys hereinabove described being within the limits of the town of Vincent, Shelby County, Alabama the assent of the mayor and aldermen of said town of Vincent to said vacation of said portions of said streets and alleys, evidenced by a resolution duly adopted by the governing body of said town of Vincent, has been procured as provided by law, and a copy thereof duly certified by the Clerk of the said town of Vincent in charge of the records of said municipality of Vincent is hereto attached as Exhibit A, to be filed and recorded as provided by law with this written declaration of vacation of said portions of said streets and alleys of the town of Arkwright, Alabama.
