Dollars, to us in hand paid by W. E. E. Oldham the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, we have this day bargained,
sold and conveyed, and do by these presents bargain,
sell and convey to the said W. E. Oldham heirs,
administrators and assigns, the following described tract
or parcel of land to wit:

South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20 Township 20 Range 2 West. and
North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of South East $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 20 Township 20 R. 2 West.
North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of North West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 20 range
2 west Less 9 acres sold to A. B. & A. Ry Co. All of
said tract containing 231 acres more or less situated and
lying and being in the Co. of Shelby and State of Alabama.

To have and to hold unto him the said W. E.
Oldham heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns,
