Forty (40) acres off of the west side of Fraction "F" or the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, Township 19, Range 3 east, containing 40 acres more or less, and leaving 12 acres on the east side of said Fraction "F".

The object of this deed is to convey to the grantee the land which was attempted to be conveyed in a deed from the grantors herein to Mrs. Plumer Smith on 24th day of August, 1915 and recorded in deed book 56 on page 534 in the Probate Office of Shelby County which deed did not properly describe the land intended to be conveyed situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
