KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the undersigned, Alabama Power Company, a corporation, for and in consideration of One dollar in hand paid by Shelby County, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby give, remise, quit claim and convey unto Shelby County, its successors and assigns, in so far as it can and has the right, and with the reservations and upon the conditions hereinafter stated, the right to construct a public road underneath, and in such a manner as not to interfere with, the electric transmission lines, telegraph and telephone lines and appliances of the company now located or which may hereafter be located over, on and across strips of land fifty feet wide described as follows:

Twenty five feet on each side of a line located as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the west right of way line of the Alabama Power Company with the center line of a road as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, designated as F. A. P. 99-B, thence north 4 degrees 08 minutes east 185 feet more or less, to the intersection of the east right of way line of the Alabama Power Company with the center line of said road, said land lying in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty five, township twenty south, range three west, Shelby County, Alabama.

Also, twenty five feet on each side of a line located as follows: beginning at the intersection of the west right of way line of the Alabama Power Company with the center line of a road as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, designated as F. A. P. 99-A, thence north 44 degrees 10 minutes east 105 feet more or less, to the intersection of the east right of way line of the Alabama Power Company with the center line of the said road, the above described tract of land lying in the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section nine, township twenty two south, range two west, Shelby County, Alabama.

And also, twenty five feet on each side of a line located as follows: beginning at the intersection of the east right of way line of the Alabama Power. Company with the center line of a road as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, designated as F. A. P. 99-B, thence north 69 degrees 29 minutes west 151 feet, more or less, to the intersection of the west right of way line of the Alabama Power Company with the center line of the said road, the above described tradt of land lying in the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section twelve, township twenty one south, range three west, Shelby County, Alabama.

The Alabama Power Company, however, reserves to itself, its successors and assigns, forever, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, and appliances necessary or convenient in connection therewith on, over and across said strips of land, together with all the rights and privileges therein necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment and use thereof for such purposes, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strips, and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstructions on said strips, and canger trees adjacent thereto where necessary.

And this conveyance is executed upon the condition that notwithstanding the grant of this easement, Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, shall have full rights, privileges and easements in respect to the construction, operation and maintenance of the electric transmission lines and of all telegraph and telephone lines,

towers, poles and appliances necessary and convenient in connection therewith over and across said strips of land on which said public road is now or is to be hereafter constructed, and upon the further condition that said strips of land shall not be used, and the grantee, its successors and assigns, shall not use said strips of land, so as to interfere with the rights herein reserved.
