To All To Whom These Presents shall come Greeting:

Whereas, Charity Maberry, Assignee of Gothard & Mardis has deposited in the General Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Gothard & Mardis according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands," for the west half of the north west quarter of Section two, in Township twenty four, of Range fourteen east, in the District of Lands offered for sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing seventy nine acres and thirty one & a half hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Gothard & Mardis.

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Charity Maberry & to her heirs the said tract above described; To have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said Charity Maberry and to her heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, John Quincy Adams President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.


