

## Affidavit

Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said County and State, personally appeared W. N. Sayer, who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says that on August 19th 1907, Mrs. S. B. Holliday, a widow was in possession of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 33, Township 17, Range 1 east, containing forty (40) acres, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, when she sold and conveyed the same to the affiant by deed dated August 19th 1907, which said deed is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book 40, page 116. Affiant further says that on said date he went into possession of said tract of land and since said time has been in the open, notorious, adverse, exclusive and continuous possession of the same and is now in possession of the same.

The affiant further says that at the time that said deed was executed and delivered to him, on August 19th, 1907, he paid to Mrs. S. B. Holliday, the grantor, the consideration of \$295.00, and that he, at that time, had no knowledge or notice or information that would put him on notice of the execution of a mortgage by Mrs. S. B. Holliday to C. F. Walters, which said mortgage was later, according to the information that has come to the affiant, recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, on November 25th 1907, in Mortgage Book 78, page 294.
