Dunston of the town of Calera; that in the map and survey of Dare, a certain street in said town of Calera, was designated as "Fulton Street" and in the survey and map of said Dunston the same street, was designated by him as "Twelfth Avenue"; that in deeds and conveyance describing lots in said town of Calera, said street is some times named Fulton Street and at others named Twelfth Avenue, but each of said names indicate the same street; I have known lots number one, two and three (1, 2 & 3) in block Nine (9) according to the J. H. Dunston survey and map of the town of Calera, Alabama, for many years, and I know of my own knowledge that William McAdory went into possession of said lot number one by deed from Lucy J. Čary during the month of August 1924 and has been in open, continuous, adverse

peaceable and actual possession of said lot since said date, and that during the month of May 1905 said William McAdory went into possession of said lots number two and three under a deed from said Lucy J. Cary, and that since said time he has been in open, continuous, peaceable and adverse possession of said lots; that affiant has lived in Calera, Alabama, since the making of said deeds and has never heard any one question the right or title of said McAdory tosaid lots; and he has his home on lot number one and a fence around lots two and three and has used them in connection with his home since 1905.

I have no interest in the title to these lands, but have been justice of the Peace at alera for mah years and have had occasion to write many deeds and to know of the property in said town and for this reason I am making this affidavit.
